TERMS OF REFERENCE (TOR)

PURPOSE

The National Electronic Media Institute of South Africa (NEMISA) invites suitably qualified service providers to submit quotations for ad-hoc support related for SAGE Evolution software.

2. BACKGROUND

NEMISA utilizes SAGE Evolution business management software for the Finance department. The software has already been implemented in the organization and ongoing support is required for the solution in place. Ten user licenses have been purchased for internal staff at the Parktown office. The organization seeks to appoint a service provider to provide **ad-hoc support for the system as and when needed.**

3. REQUIREMENTS FOR QUOTATIONS

1.3 ELIMINATION OF PROPOSALS ON GROUNDS OF FUNCTIONALITY

1.3.1 Quotes that score less than **70%** of the marks available for functionality will be eliminated from further consideration. Marks will therefore not be awarded for their cost proposals or for preference.

1.4 PRICE AND B-BBEE STATUS LEVEL POINTS

1.5 ADJUDICATION OF BID

1.5.1 The relevant award structure will consider the recommendations and make the final award. The successful bidder will usually be the service provider scoring the highest number of points or it may be a lower scoring bid on justifiable grounds or no award at all.


